Directions:

Parking and Starts are at the far end of Cambourne Business Park.

Grid Ref: TL313600

What3Words: snoring.clef.collide

By Car: Best Postcode for SatNav is CB23 6EA. Parking is in a carpark with a maximum height restriction of 2.1 m.

Public Transport: The guided bus (Citi-4) operates between Cambridge and Cambourne. There is a bus stop on Cambourne road close to the Business Park. According to Stagecoach website this service is operating hourly, the first bus leaving Cambridge Drummer St Bus Station at 9:10 am. Please check before you travel if you intend to use this service.

Please take care when approaching the parking area and give way to orienteers on foot and other pedestrians.

Courses and Registration:

Please note, as this is an urban event, unaccompanied Under 16s (on the day of the event) will be restricted to run White, Yellow and Orange courses. They must be accompanied for other courses.

First Start is 10.30am

Courses close at 2.30pm. Competitors must have finished by this time

IMPORTANT: Please report to the Download desk even if you do not finish your course.

Course lengths are subject to final controlling. Course lengths below are given as straight-line distances, but due to the nature of an urban event actual distances run by competitors will be greater.

1	Brown	20	9.6 km	Under 16's must be accompanied. Double sided map.
2	Blue	16	6.6 km	Under 16's must be accompanied. Single sided map.
3	Green	14	5.1 km	Under 16's must be accompanied. Single sided map.
4	Short Green	15	3.7 km	Under 16's must be accompanied. Single sided map.
5	Light Green	13	4.1 km	Under 16's must be accompanied. Single sided map.
6	Orange	16	3.3 km	Single Sided Map
7	Yellow	13	2.4 km	Single Sided Map
8	White	10	1.5 km	Single Sided Map

Course Notes:

- White, Yellow and Orange have some controls close together so be careful checking control numbers.
- Maps for White and Yellow will be available in the pre-start.
- Cambourne is reasonably quiet on a Sunday morning but please be respectful of the local community when competing.

Facilities: One portable toilet unit will be provided near to the parking area. No water or drinks will be provided- please bring your own drinks.

Starts and Finishes:

The start and finish are both approx. 200m from the car park entrance.

Map and Terrain:

Starting and finishing in the Cambourne Business Park, courses explore a mix of the parks and green spaces of Cambourne, along with urban sections for courses from Light Green upwards. Due to road crossings on these longer courses, unaccompanied U16s (on the day of the event) are restricted to White, Yellow and Orange. Yellow and Orange courses include a marshalled road crossing.

Cambourne is mainly flat, so there is minimal elevation change across the area, with exception of the country park.

Only main paths are mapped in open areas. Others may come and go according to the season.

Although mainly an urban area the map is at 1:10000 with 5m contours and is drawn to ISOM 2017-2 not ISSprOM.

Safety:

Take care for the usual hazards such as steps and rough ground. Please show consideration to other competitors, and pedestrians including dog-owners and cyclists.

As this is an urban event, care must be taken when crossing roads.

Competitors take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety.

A First aid box will be located in the download tent.
