

The East Anglian Orienteering Association welcomes you too the **Midland Championships 2024** incorporating the **BUCS Individual races** and the **East Anglian Championships** at Sandringham Royal Park, West Norfolk on Saturday 9th March 2024



FINAL DETAILS

Vehicles — the car park has no height barrier. Large vehicles including Camper vans, Minibuses and Vans to park at the south end of the car park.

To exit the car park: at the pay point shelter enter registration of vehicle; when prompted enter the event code **** that will be shown on the bottom of your results (splits) printout – then exit car park within 20 minutes.

Assembly Area / Car Park – Compass Point Orienteering Equipment shop will be attending. East Anglian Junior Squad will be having a Bake Sale (you will need some cash for a tasty treat)

Club Tents – can be erected along the run-in to the Finish.

Starts – please note that all competition courses will use a Timed Start – not a punching start!

Start times can be viewed on the Fabian4 website. Some start times have been adjusted since first displayed, so please check. If you are unhappy with the start time currently shown, please contact midlandentries@waoc.org.uk but bear in mind there is limited scope to make changes.

Your run time will be based on the published start time. Please aim to arrive at the start ready for your allocated start slot, allowing for 4-minute call up. If you arrive late report to the start officials who will find you the next available start for your course.

Please make sure you take only one map when you start, and make sure this is the correct map for the course and class you have entered.

Course 6 – make sure you pick up the correct scale map for your class: M55L map is 1:10:000, W18E/20E/35L and BUCS-WA/MB map is 1:15,000. There will be separate map trays for these in the course 6 start lane.

The start window has been extended beyond 12:30pm for BUCS-MA and BUCS-WA competitors due volume of entries and seeding.

M90 class will run course 14. W90 class will run course 15.

We apologise for a typo on the initial details which had M14B mentioned twice in the course to class table and M16B omitted. M16B should run course 16 and M14B should run course 18.

Finish – this will be in beacon mode (as will all course controls) so non-contact punching is enabled for those running with SIAC dibbers. Please go directly from the finish to download.

Hired SI-cards – should be collected from enquiries before going to the start.

Trophy collection – *if you have an EA or Midlands Championship trophy, remember to bring it with you and hand to enquiries when you arrive.*

Trophy presentation - will take place approximately 14.15

Sandringham Parkrun – we know that some orienteers like to do a Parkrun when the opportunity arises, and there will be a ParkRun at Sandringham earlier on the morning of the event. However, our controller has confirmed that **anyone who runs the Parkrun course on the day will be rendered non-competitive in the championships!**
