Milton Country Park, Milton, near Cambridge. **Postcode for Sat Nav: CB24 6AZ**

From the A14: Take junction 33 signed Milton/ A10. Take the Milton exit from the A10/A14 roundabout down into the village. At the Tesco roundabout turn right to drive through a small industrial estate. The car park entrance can be found at the end of this road. We will be near the café.

Facilities: Café and toilets, car park (fee payable). Guidance for beginners available from Registration. First Aid will be located at Download.

Registration is near the café. Start is close to registration.

Times: Registration and enquiries between 10.30am to 12.30pm with starts from 10.45am to 12.45 pm.

Start times will not be pre-allocated.

Courses close at 2 pm - you must report to Download by this time.

We will be using pin punches.

Prices: Adults £4 Groups £5 Juniors and students £2

IMPORTANT: Please report to Download even if you do not finish your course.

Map and Terrain: Courses are within the country park. Wooded and open areas with lakes. Map is A4 size printed on non-waterproof paper. Control descriptions on maps only.

Courses: Short/White ~1.2km, very easy
 Medium/Yellow ~1.6km, easy
 Long/Orange ~2.3km, more difficult

Safety: Within the park, take care for the usual hazards such as tripping and eye-level branches and exercise caution within car parking areas. There is deep water associated with the lake. There is a well-defined path around the lake. Please show consideration to other park users including dog-owners and cyclists. Competitors take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety.

A First aid box will be located at download. If the weather is bad, please carry a cagoule. Dogs are permitted if kept under control.
