



Standon Meadows Score Event

A 45 minute score event, with 33 control sites, in the picturesque Rib valley in rural Hertfordshire. The 1:7500 map of Standon village and the meadows bordering the river Rib has been updated - the area is not large or technical but the route choices available and general time management should make an interesting score event.

Parking Limited space in pub car park otherwise on surrounding roads, there are no parking restrictions.

Directions The Star pub is opposite St Mary's church on Standon High Street, roughly 300m south of its junction with the A120. This junction is 1.6km East of the A10 and 13km West of the M11 junction 8. The cunning route is down the B1368 from Flint Cross and through Puckeridge village.

Notes You may want to cross the river at one of two shallow crossing points so please bring spare socks and shoes!

There are some nettles in places so full leg cover is strongly recommended.

There may be a few cows in one field, they are very used to walkers and will ignore us completely.
